Key Knowledge and Skills

By the end of this unit children will...

will develop their understanding of a range of tools used for digital painting. They then use these tools to create their own digital paintings, while gaining inspiration from a range of artists' work.

Digital Painting

We can use digital devices to help us draw and paint pictures. Some of the programs we can use to do this are Microsoft Paint and Paintz. When use paint programs, we can use \underline{tools} to create different effects.

Tools



This is the <u>pencil tool</u>. It draws freehand. As we click and hold the left mouse button, it draws on the page. As we hold and move the mouse / finger on the track pad, the pencil follows.

This is the <u>paint brush tool</u>. It works freehand, similar to the pencil tool. However, we can choose different colours to paint with.



The <u>eraser tool</u> lets us rub out parts of our drawings when we have made a mistake. It works by clicking and holding the left mouse button over the areas to erase.

The <u>undo tool</u> reverses the last thing that you did. If you make a mistake, the undo tool can help you to get your drawing back to how it was beforehand!



More Complex tools



This is the <u>fill tool.</u> It lets us fill a shape with a colour of our choice. Be careful though, if the shape has any gaps the fill tool will colour everything else!

This is the <u>spray tool</u>. When you hold down the left button on the mouse, it is like you are spraying a can of spray paint. With this tool, it is more difficult to colour neatly.





The <u>line tools</u> are useful when we need to draw a line more neatly than we can freehand. You can select the start and end points of your line, and choose if you want it straight or curvy.

The <u>shape tools</u> draw perfectly formed shapes! There many different shapes to choose from. As we click and drag, we make the shape bigger or smaller.

erase – when we rub out parts of a

click – pressing the button on the mouse

drag — when you have clicked on an object, hold the left hand mouse button down to move the object / make it bigger or smaller.

save — when you have finished your work, it is important to save it using an appropriate file name.
