Key Knowledge

By the end of this half term children will.

- Be able to name the four countries in the United Kingdom. England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
- Be able to find the four countries on a map of the UK.
- Be able to name the capital cities of the four countries. London, Cardiff, Edinburgh, Belfast.
- Be able to recognise the flags of the four countries.
- Be able to name the seas that surround the United Kingdom. Irish Sea, English Channel, North Sea, Atlantic Ocean.
- Be able to use compass directions to describe the location of the countries and seas. EG The English Channel is to the South of the United Kingdom. Scotland is in the north of the United Kingdom.
- Be able to join in with activities celebrating St Andrew's day.

GEOGRAPHICAL SKILLS AND FIELDWORK

Children will investigate the school and forest school areas and observe what they can see; including the explanations of the weather and games practicing the compass direction skills. They will travel to the city centre for the Crucible trip and observe and talk about human and physical features around the city.
