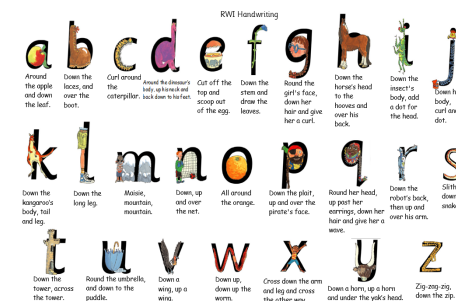
## Science Winter Photography Competition
