- We have been learning about fractions and how to find $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of numbers.

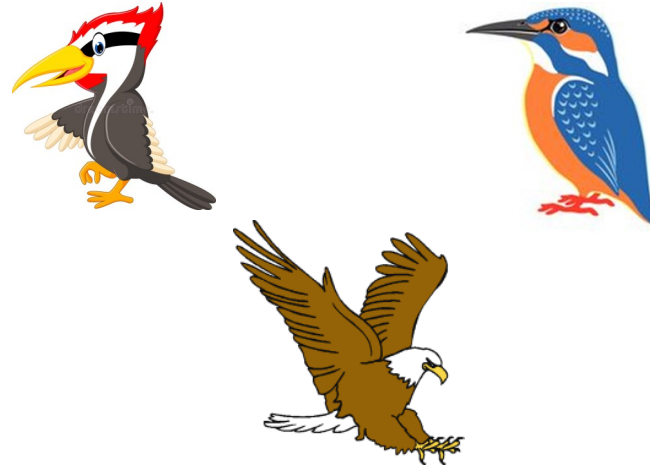
Solve these fraction equations using the sharing method:
