By the end of this unit pupils will..

be able to discuss and sequence main events in the story of “Billy and the Dragon”, as well as using key vocabulary taught in class to write information sentences about a dragon of their own imagining.

“Billy and the Dragon” is a fiction story about a courageous girl called Billy who is enjoying a fancy dress party with her cat, FatCat, who is dress up as a baby dragon. Suddenly, out of nowhere a massive (and real) dragon swoops down and grabs FatCat and flies off with him. Billy finds a telescope and manages to spot a very unhappy FatCat far away in a tall tree in the deep, dark forest. Billy sets off to rescue him, but it isn't as easy as she thought it would be. Then Billy finds a small dragon that has got lost, she starts to guess what might have happened.
