Key Knowledge

By the end of this half term children will.

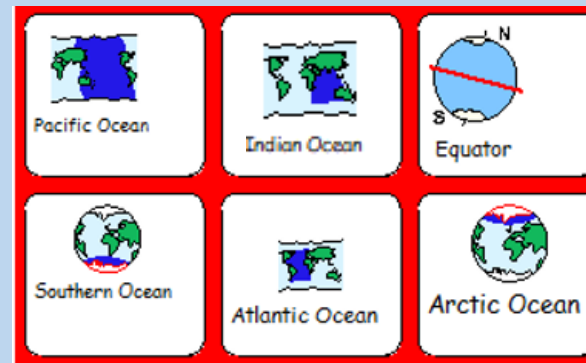
- To be able to recall the world's seven continents. Africa, America, Asia, Europe, Oceania, North America, South America.
- Be able to name the world's five oceans. Indian, Arctic, Atlantic, Southern, Pacific.
- Be able to locate the world's 5 oceans on a map and a globe.
- Be able to explain that an ocean is a large body of salt water.
- Be able to identify the equator as an imaginary line that goes around the centre of the earth and draw this on a map.
- Be able to identify the northern and southern hemispheres as the two parts the world is split into by the equator.
- To identify the location of hot and cold areas of the world. For example. Antarctica is a cold continent.

GEOGRAPHICAL SKILLS AND FIELDWORK

Children will investigate with world maps, atlases and globes to identify the continents and location of the oceans.

They will use observational skills to investigate ocean facts.
