

Second hand uniform

Attendance & Punctuality

Attendance target 2024–25: 97.5%. Currently school is at 97.9% (98% last week). A reminder that the chief medical officer encourages children to attend school if they have a cold, however if they have sickness, or diarrhoea, they need to remain absent for 48 hours after the last time this occurs. Attendance as often as possible is important for your child.

Punctuality: It is important that you aim to be in school for the start time. This is 8.55am in Foundation Stage and 9am in Y1 and Y2. This is the time your child needs to be on the carpet, things put away ready for register and to learn, not when you are arriving at the entrance. Arriving late is disruptive both to your own child and the rest of the class. It is also likely your child will have missed some key learning for the day.

This week **0.56%** of children were marked as late.

Ask me about...

Each week your class teacher will update this area with information about what your chid has been learning during the week so that you can ask them questions about it.

Ladybirds

This week Ladybirds have continued reading the story "The Leaf Thief" by Alice Hemming. We have been learning about 2d shapes in maths so have been making the squirrel a house using different 2d shapes. We have also been on shape hunt around our classroom.

We have been to forest school where the ladybirds have loved looking for signs of Autumn, we have collected leaves which we have used to make pictures with. We have also started doing 'dough disco' which we have loved!

Next week we will start to read our new focus text "The Wide Awake Hedgehog" by Rosie Wellesley and talk about the different features of a hedgehog.

Foundation Stage Two (Otters, Mice and Badgers)

This week we have been reading the story of the Stickman, written by Julia Donaldson. You can watch an animated version of the story <u>here</u>.

We have been making our own stickmen in the making area of the classroom and talking about similarities and differences between our stickmen and those belonging to our friends.

We have learnt about different ways to measure length, weight, and capacity. We have explored this in the classroom and outside, and used mathematical language to compare different objects (heavier, lighter, longer, shorter, full, empty).

In PE, we are learning different ways to move our bodies. We have learnt a variety of different warm up games, and are noticing what happens to our bodies when we exercise (for example; our heart rate getting faster, being out of breath).

Children continue to share their Thirst for Knowledge seasons representations in class. Please see information above about this if your child has not yet brought theirs into school.

Y1 (Hedgehogs, Squirrels and Foxes)

English – we have been learning how to write ladder letters, which are letters that have straight lines –

I i j u t y. We have also learned about using adjectives to describe nouns, focusing on our text of the Gruffalo.

Maths – We have been learning about using the less than, greater than or equal to signs to compare objects, numbers or representations. We then built on this learning and used these signs to compare numbers.

Geography – We have learned the compass points North, South, East and West.

Science – We have been building or designing dens for the Gruffalo. He even made a special appearance in our assembly – see the pictures on X.

Computing – We have learnt and practiced typing and editing on a keyboard.

RE – We have been learning about the Harvest festival and how Christians would say 'thank you' to God.

Art – We have created continuous line drawings of shells, which is where artists do not take their drawing tool off the paper.

Music – We had a Music in the Round workshop with John from the Crucible. We practiced singing the songs for the performance next week. The songs are One Family of Goats, The Kid's Song and Rock Rounders. You can listen to these songs here: https://musicintheround.co.uk/giddy_goat_resource_hub/

Y2 (Woodpeckers, Kingfishers and Eagles)

English – we are learning about coordinating conjunctions and using "and" and "but" to join two simple sentences together.

Maths – we are using dienes to add and subtract from a ten and crossing tens (e.g. -20-7, 17-9)

RE – each class is going tovisit a local mosque. Each class still needs volunteers to accomany us for our safety ratios. Please see the inforamtion and letter above.

DT – we have designed a vehicle with wheels and axles and will be making these using junk modelling in the week beginning 14th October. Please bring in a box/bottle for your vehicle and any other crafty materials you need next week.
