

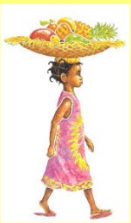

swallowing jumping shouting walking

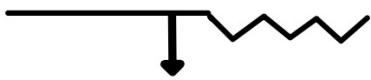
A **past tense verb** is an action that is happened **in the past**.

swallowed jumped shouted walked

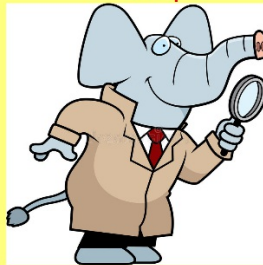

Regular verbs can be changed to past tense by adding **-ed**.



Do all past tense **verbs** end in -ed?

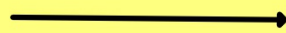

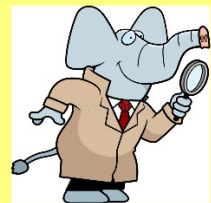

Regular verbs end in 'ed'.

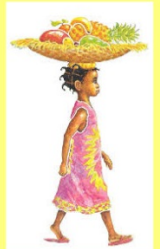
Irregular verbs do not!

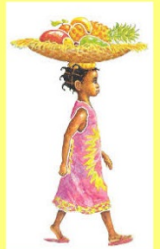
