What are our rules when using '**and**' in a sentence?

1. '**and**' brings two parts of a sentence together.
2. '**and**' should only be used **once** in a sentence.
3. A comma is used **before** the word '**and**'
4. '**and**' is a **co-ordinating conjunction**.
