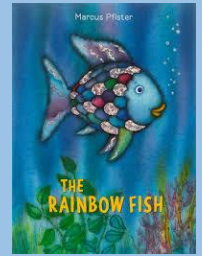
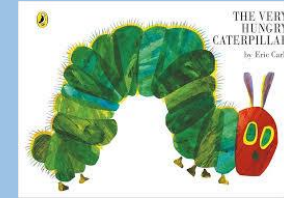

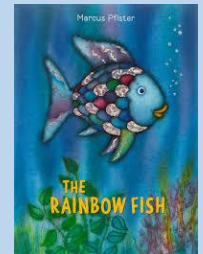

Remember all double facts to 10



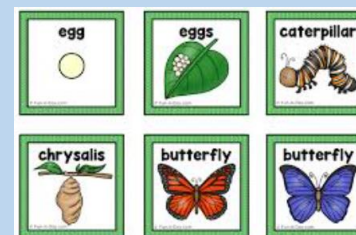
