For example

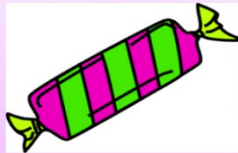
"Lovely looking lollies"

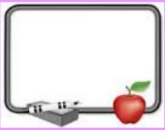
