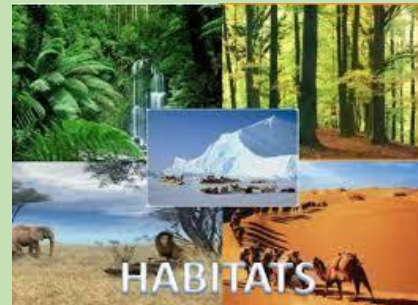
Continents, Europe, Africa, Asia, North America, South America, Australia, Antarctica.
