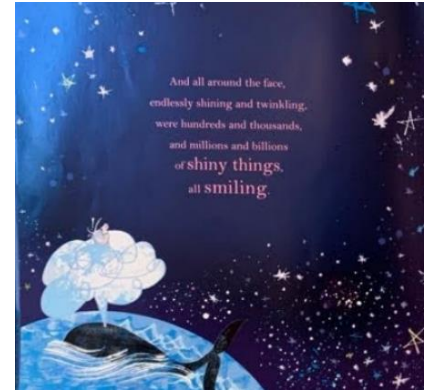
**Context:** Squiglet Pig

- they join a subordinating clause that adds detail to the main clause (e.g.- When it is raining, we play inside.)
- you **don't** need a commas before one
- they can go at the start **OR** in the middle of a sentence
